And wiggle my waggles away.

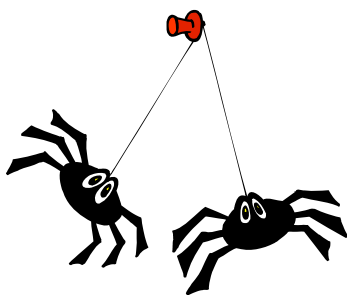
Gotta clap, clap, clap my crazies out...
