Engine Engine Number Nine

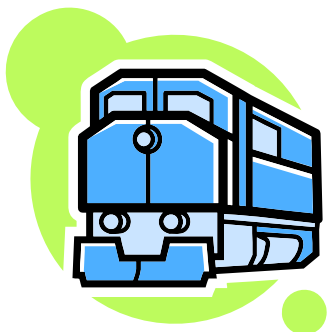
Engine, Engine Number Nine
