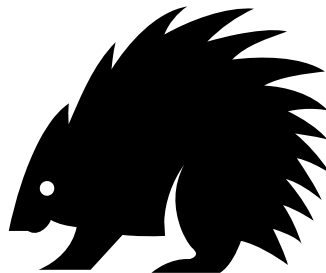
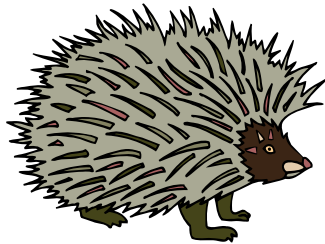
Do Not Touch the Animals

Bob-tailed cats have wicked jaws.

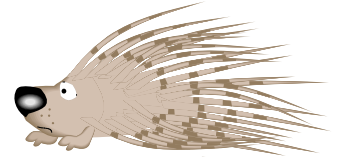


The Lonely Porcupine
